ROSTRAVER PUBLIC LIBRARY RECEIVES GRANT FOR BUILDING ENERGY AUDIT

Rostraver Township, PA – The Rostraver Public Library (RPL) has received a grant from the West Penn Power Sustainable Energy Fund (WPPSEF) to obtain an energy audit of their building. The audit will be the first step in the Library’s commitment to utilizing more sustainable energy options. The RPL Board of Directors will use the results to develop an implementation strategy for the recommended alterations. RPL has authorized Envinity, Inc. of State College to administer an energy audit of their facilities at 700 Plaza Drive in Rostraver Township with the support of WPPSEF.

“We are immensely grateful for the support of WPPSEF in our attempt to become more responsible with our resources. This audit will kick off a great opportunity to provide valuable information to our community while providing us with more efficient and effective operations,” says Naomi Cross, RPL Director.

Joel Morrison, WPPSEF Fund Administrator, stated: “Our funding of this activity will provide the library with a comprehensive plan to better understand their energy use within their facility and to prioritize actions to reduce their operating costs. This fits well with the mission of the WPPSEF to reinvest in local communities to help reduce energy usage through technology.”
