online with your
Library Card!



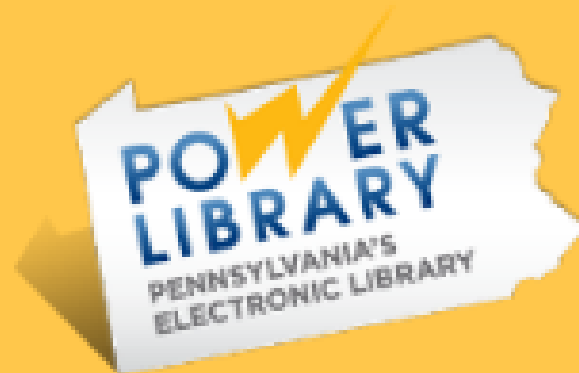
1.

**Go to the Library's website:
www.rostraverlibrary.org**



2.

Click on the
Power Library icon



on the right side of the
screen.



3.

At this point, you may be asked for the barcode on your library card

(if you haven't already logged in to your library account.)



4.

Scroll down the long list of Power Library databases until you find the icon for General OneFile.



Click on the icon.



5.

After the General OneFile front page loads, look at the far bottom-right corner and click "Go To Publication Search"



6.

A search box will load.

**Type in "Washington Post"
or "New York Times".**



7.

**Click on the one
result that you want that
appears for your search.**

(There may be more than one result.)



8.

**You will now see a
chronological list of dates
for the newspaper.
Click on the date that you
would like to read.**

**(There may be a one-day lag time
before an issue appears online.)**



9.

Scroll through the list of articles published for that date and read what you like.

You can also download, print, or save full-text articles in PDF format.
